**\*Any 3600-series cat or kitten with a 3600-series parent can be re-registered (or registered) with a SH-600-series prefix upon presentation of DNA proof that the cat/kitten does not carry any of the longhair mutations. Such registration or re-registration will be at the owner's expense.**

## **BREED NOTES**

### **BREED: MANX**

**Longhair Manx was once called Cymric. (LH Manx effective 5/1/1994)**

**The AOV class is only for tailed cats. There are no other AOV colors/patterns.**

**(2/99 effective 5/99): Tabby and whites (except silver tabby and white) are shown as Bi-colors**

**(As of 2/12): All tabby and whites (including silver tabby and white) are shown in the Tabby and White color class - 0692-3. And any patched tabby and white is shown in the Tabby and White color class.**

**(2/15) Smoke and white (does not include the calico/torties) are shown in the Bi-color class.**

**(2/15) removed prohibition on Ticked tabby thus bringing Color description into compliance with ROR**

**Any color or pattern of cat with no more white than a locket and/or button should be registered in the class for their dominant color – not in the bi-color class. (Per BCS notes 7/14)**

**Vans are registered and shown as Bi-color or as tabby and white if the tabby pattern can be seen. (Per BCS notes 7/14)**

**OMC Show Class: (02/15) Any other color or pattern with the exception of those showing hybridization resulting in the colors chocolate, lavender, the Himalayan pattern, or those combinations with white.**
