

ADDENDUM TO 2016-2018 CLERKING MANUAL: MASTER CLERK DUTIES

Page 32: Marking the Catalog; Class Awards

The chart and examples indicating the prescribed catalog markings have been revised to eliminate the reference and notations for Winners ribbons. The revised Page 32 is attached.

Page 45: Master Breed/Division Award Sheets – Finals Sheets

Effective April 30, 2016, Master Clerks are no longer be required to complete the Master Clerk Breed/Division Awards sheets (Appendix F). Use of the Master Clerk Breed/Division Awards sheets is strictly optional. Master Clerks may wish to use the sheets as an aid in checking ring finals or for their own personal record keeping.

Page 47: Unofficial Count

Effective September 17, 2016, cats or kittens competing in the ID-China area (excluding the special administrative areas of Hong Kong and Macau) must be present in 80% of the rings in order to be included in the unofficial count.

Effective November 1, 2016, cats or kittens competing in the ID-China area (excluding the special administrative areas of Hong Kong and Macau) that receive a DISQ, NA/IM or NA/COND in a ring will be considered absent in that ring.

Please refer to Show Rules 11.23, 11.24, 28.02, and Article XXXVI, Show Points, Official Show Count, Item 3 for complete details regarding the unofficial count.

















Page 52: Central Office Checklist; and Page 53: Club Copy Checklist

Effective April 30, 2016, Master Clerks are no longer be required to submit completed Master Clerk Breed/Division Awards sheets to the CFA Central Office in the show package, or to provide copies to the club with the show records. Master Clerks may wish to keep a copy of the sheets for their own records.

- It is recommended to include the catalog page number of the cat involved in the transfer. The ring clerk must be sure to place the transferred cat in its proper division and identify the new color class number.

Other Markings

These catalog markings are all marked **above** the line:

Catalog Marking	Description
XXX	Judge's breeding / not eligible in ring
DISQ	Disqualification
NA	No Award – all wins withheld
WC	Wrong Color – no award presented

If wins are withheld, the catalog must show the reason stated by the judge, written as:

Catalog Marking	Description
IM	Insufficient Merit
Cond	Condition
UT	Undescended Testicle(s)
