(As of 2/12): All tabby and whites (including silver tabby and white) are shown in the Tabby and White color class - 0692-3. And any patched tabby and white is shown in the Tabby and White color class.

(2/15) Smoke and white (does not include the calico/torties) are shown in the Bicolor class.

(2/15) removed prohibition on Ticked tabby thus bringing Color description into compliance with ROR
