

noted in this article in previous years, the title of DM or Distinguished Merit is one of the most prized titles that a cat can achieve in CFA. A distinguished merit cat is either a male that has sired 15 or more grand or DM offspring, or a female that has thrown five or more grand or DM offspring. This title means that the cat has contributed a lasting legacy to their breed by passing their wonderful type and attributes on to future generations.

The cattery that has produced the greatest number of CFA registered DM cats continues to be South Paw, a Persian cattery owned by Greg and Judy Brocato. The Brocatos have not been breeding cats for a number of years, but still sit at the top with 27 DMs. Our new holder of the second spot is Marianne Clark, Kurisumasu Japanese Bobtails, with 19 DMs. In third place is another inactive breeder, Janet and Bob Bassetti, of Bassetti Japanese Bobtails.

Perusing the list of distinguished merit males, there has been no change at the top. The first eight cats, led by GC, NW Cinna's Jack Daniels of Chantebise, DM with 53, has not changed for a number of years. I think it is interesting to note that of the top eight males historically, four of them are Abyssinians.

The top female DMs do not seem to be as dominated by any one breed; the highest ranking Abyssinian female is in eighth place, in comparison to the males where an Abyssinian ranks first, fourth, fifth and eighth. In contrast to the male rankings, CH Wil-o-glen's Gold Card of Clarion, DM and GC Abyville Skittles of Eecatl, DM are the only female Abyssinian DMs to appear in the top nine rankings (which, due to ties, actually includes 35 different cats).

Most breeds/divisions that are recognized by CFA now include a female DM. The only exceptions are the American Bobtail Shorthair, the Manx Longhair, Selkirk Rex Longhair and Shorthair and the Siberian. However, there are still 10 breeds/divisions that do not have a male DM – the American Bobtail Longhair, American Bobtail Shorthair, American Curl Shorthair, European Burmese, Manx Longhair, Oriental Longhair, Selkirk Rex Longhair and Shorthair, Siberian and the Sphynx. All of these breeds are relatively new to CFA's championship ranks and with time, they will surely qualify a distinguished merit cat.

Now for the fun stuff – one of the best parts of this yearly article is this part – those cats that were *firsts*, reached milestones or were in some other way a special contributor to their breed's history.

One of the firsts is L Bee's Calamity Jane of NuDawnz, DM a silver classic tabby American Bobtail Longhair female. "Jane" is the first American Bobtail to earn the title of DM, and she did it in the American Bobtail's first year of championship competition in CFA! Her breeder is Lynn Benson and her owner is Lorna Friemoth. This is also the first time that a new breed in CFA has had a national winner and a DM in their first year of acceptance. Further, Jane counts among her offspring two of CFA's other firsts – her daughter GP NuDawnz Iskali Chola of Shelbie, CFA's first American Bobtail Shorthair grand and another daughter, GC NuDawnz Mustang Sally, CFA's first longhair female grand champion. Congratulations to "Calamity Jane" and her breeder and owners!

Another first for the past show season is GC, GP, BW, RW Dollhowse Denver Blues of Kebekat, DM - whew, so many titles! "Denver" is bred by Janeil Cillessen and is owned by Isabelle Bellevance. He is the first male Ragdoll DM, and is a second generation DM titleholder, not bad for a breed so relatively new to CFA. His mother, CH Dollhowse Princess Leah, DM, was the first Ragdoll DM, and her son is proud to follow in her footsteps to achieve the distinction of being the first male Ragdoll DM. Denver is a blue point and white Ragdoll and was the breed's first National Breed Winner in the 2000-2001 show season, the first for the Ragdolls in CFA. He was also the first Ragdoll to achieve the RW title, which he earned as a kitten. Denver has sired 16 grands to date, including six with CH Kebekat Cinnabon, DM, from two litters. There is not much else for Denver to do, except enjoy his well earned, lazy, senior years, admiring all that he has done for the Ragdoll breed.

Another first is CH Edelweiss Arwen Evenstar of Pavir, DM. She is a chocolate point Balinese bred by Gisela Zanelli and owned by Virginia Torsch and Paul Blose. "Evenstar" was bred to GC, BW, NW Purrmatix EveryonewantstobelikeMike, DM, a seal point Balinese male bred by Terrie and Bruce Smith and Patty Vail and owned by Terrie and Bruce Smith and Virginia Wheeldon;

and they produced six kittens, five of which were show quality. Those five were shown and all granded, making Evenstar the first one litter Balinese DM in CFA.

GC, RW Idlemaine Butler of Texas Belle, DM, a black and white Maine Coon male, is now tied as the Maine Coon with the most grand offspring in CFA. His son, GC Texas Belle B. Red Rover became his 37th grand champion, passing the previous record of 36, held by GC, NW Kanab's Luanne's Mahogany Rush, DM.

To prove that "It is all in the breeding," "Butler's" grandparents came from the same cattery as the cat that he ultimately passed, "Mahogany Rush." GC, RW Stormwatch Dirtrack Demon of Nascat, DM, owned by Donna Hinton and Jill and Dave Burrow, also now has 37 grand offspring, so there is a tie at the top of the male Maine Coon ladder. It's amazing that these two wonderful boys passed a record that had been held for so long, in the same year.

Another milestone was achieved by Spellbound Stormy, DM, a black smoke Exotic female bred and owned by Bob and Diane Deibert. "Stormy" is a homozygous Exotic and actually DM'd in 2002-2003. In this past year, Stormy produced her 14th grand offspring, becoming the Exotic female with the highest number of grand offspring. Stormy was the sole kitten produced from GC Spellbound New Vision x CH Bassetti's Powderedsugar. Diane says she was nothing really special type wise (she didn't even earn the title of champion), but she had lovely doming and huge eyes. Stormy is now eight years old and continuing to produce normal size, healthy litters of kittens.


This year's DMs include several with very international flavor. The first Birman DM bred and owned by a Japanese exhibitor was bred and owned by Kayoko Otsu and Kaori Seki. Her name is **CH Suzucat Xana**, **DM**, and she is a chocolate point female. Her sire is GC Birjanji Reality Checque and her dam is GC Whitesox Velvet Love Bear.

Also on the international front is CH Ormeryrds Karina, DM, a brown tabby Exotic female born in Sweden in 1997. Her sire is Yquem Mezcel (sired by CFA's 1991 Cat of the Year, GC, NW Jovan The Legend of Yquem) and her dam is Athelstones Gossip. Her proud breeder and owner is Anna Lange of Sweden. Her qualifying offspring also have an international twist - GC, RW Ormeryrds Short N'Sweet of Catipurrn was shown by Dana Crabtree in the United States; GC, RW Ormeryrds John-Eric of Mockingbird was shown by Lee Harper and Jodell Raymond, also in the U.S.; GC Ormeryrds Johanna was owned and shown by Kayoko Koizumi in Japan; GC Ormeryrds John-John was owned and shown by Masaaki Kon in Japan; and GP Ormeryrds Ernesto Bertarelli was owned by Tony Chan and Ray Wong and shown in Hong Kong. These five grands made "Karina" the first CFA DM in Scandinavia. Anna would like to thank the owners of all of Karina's offspring for showing them to their grand title for Karina.

Another notable DM with international ties is Catsafrats Blue Ice, DM, a blue point Himalayan female bred by Donna and Bruce Isenberg and owned by Donna and Bruce Isenberg and B. Farris. "Blue Ice" was never shown but was bred to Catsafrats Starting Over of Kapulo, a black colorpoint carrier male, also untitled. That breeding produced five

grand champions in one litter! Three of them, GC, RW Catsafrats It Started With A Kiss (now residing in France), GC Catsafrats Rock Star (also residing in France), and GC Catsafrats Start Your Engines (now residing in Italy), have moved abroad to contribute to breeding programs overseas. Littermates GC Catsafrats Kick Start (living in Missouri) and GC Catsafrats Little Super Star (living in California) opted to stay in the states to finish mama's DM title. Donna says that before she bred Blue Ice, she had been trying to place her, and then bred her to "Starting Over" in the hopes of getting a pointed offspring. They produced six kittens, three seal point females and three black CPC males, all grand quality. For Donna and Bruce it was a dream come true. Donna notes that everything happens for a reason, and having been unable to place Blue Ice for some time, then finally deciding to breed her (an untitled female) to an untitled male which produced such a wonderful litter, was a great accomplishment. Blue Ice is now retired to the desert, living in Phoenix, Arizona with Arlene Gysler and living the life of the queen that she knows she is.

One of Marianne Clark's two DMs for the past show season also had an international twist. **CH Kurisumasu Takeda**, **DM** finished her title after she was sent to new owners Richard and Yan Horton in Wales, U.K. Her last grand, GC Kurisumasu Kotenshi of Songgwangsa, was granded under the auspices of Olivier Grin of Aciens, Switzerland at a CFA show in Kiev, Ukraine. This was indeed a pleasant surprise for Marianne and a truly international effort.

Yet another of Marianne's cats that DM'd this past show season was GC, BW, RW Kurisumasu Jitto's Tessen, DM. "Tessen" is a fifth generation DM and is co-owned by and lives with Susan Eckert. Tessen achieved her DM title when her daughter GP Katsuma Kemuri of Kurisumasu, CFA's first black smoke and white Japanese Bobtail grand, achieved her title. The title was rather bittersweet as it was earned posthumously for Marianne. We would like to thank Susan for her loving care of Tessen.

A Sable Burmese male, CH Laki's Diabolique of Gray Mark, DM (known

affectionately as "Bobby"), bred by Richard and Barbara Kish and owned by Margaret and Ray Stevens, has some unique qualifications. He is the son of two DMs, which is somewhat unusual for the Burmese breed. Bobby helped to produce two female DMs in the Burmese breed. One of them, GC, GP Laki's Bettie Boop of Gray Mark, DM, produced four grands in one litter including a regional winner when bred to Bobby. A fifth, CH, GP Gray Mark's Blue Lace, was in a subsequent litter. Margaret reports that "Blue Lace" now lives with a family that loves to go sailing and sails every weekend, weather permitting of course.

Bobby was also bred to CH, PR Shaineh's Moriah of Nightsong, DM and produced three grands with her. In addition to the regional winner above, Bobby also produced a national breed winner in the dilute division (twice!), GC, RW Gray Mark's Bonnie Dune, and he also has two granddaughters who were national breed winners - GC, PR, BW, RW Gray Mark's Amethyst who was Best of Breed nationally, 2004 and GC, RW Gray Mark Baby Ruth of Bear Country, who was Third Best of Breed nationally, 2005. A great granddaughter, GC Gray Mark's Aurora, was Third Best of Breed nationally, 2006. A grandson, GC, BW, RW Bon Marche Diablo, bred and owned by Ken and Suzanne Berrin, achieved a national Best of Breed, 2006. Bobby's offspring have been shared with Burmese breeders throughout the U.S. and Canada. Margaret reports that he is a wonderful pet who loves to play with his daughters, great granddaughters and great-great granddaughters...go Gramps!

When most people think of a Norwegian Forest Cat, they think of brown tabby and white, right? Well, CH Kashi Saga Harrigan Thatsme of Irlu, DM, aka "Harry," is the exception to that thought. Harry was bred by Barbara Chronakis – lessee, is owned by Joe Eppolito and Mary Mulrennan and is the first red tabby and white Wegie to attain the coveted title. Mary and Joe considered it their mission to have folks see other beautiful colors in the breed, which they surely accomplished. In a breed clearly dominated by the brown tabby and white

color, only *one* of Harry's 15 qualifying offspring is a brown tabby and white. Most notable among his offspring are GC, NW Irlu Glendalough Roisin of Redzone, CFA's Second Best Kitten and highest scoring longhair kitten in 2002-2003, and GC, BW, NW Redzone Gwendolynne Roisin of Irlu, who was CFA's first Norwegian Forest Cat female National Winner and Breed Winner. She is also the first cream and white Wegie to gain the awards. Harry has also sired three regional winners in the North Atlantic Region, along with his two national winners.

Mary reports that Harry is now 8 ½ years old and is a big, easy going teddy bear, who lives with three non-breeding females that just adore him. They look over him and protect him (they think) from other invading females. He has passed on his great type, thick dense double coat, robust health and wonderful personality to his offspring.


Distinguished merit cats that carry on through multiple generations are proof that a breeding program is successful, and Melanie Morgan of Emau Cattery demonstrated that clearly in the 2006-2007 show season. CH Emau's Jump For Joy of Mautrix, DM, a silver Egyptian Mau female bred by Melanie and David Morgan and owned by Laurie Coughlan and Melanie Morgan, became the first Egyptian Mau female whose father and mother were both DMs. In addition, on her mother's side, she was a third generation DM and on her father's side, she was a second generation DM. Her offspring are GC Mautrix Caprice, GC, RW Mautrix Fairylights, GC Mautrix Happily Ever After, GC Mautrix Miss Mau Fit and GC Mautrix Twilight Song, all silver females; and GP Mautrix Starry Knight, a silver neuter. In addition, Emau's Grand Illusion, DM, another silver female bred by Melanie, David and L. Morgan and A. Cooper and owned by Susan Melia, earned her DM title in May 2006 and became a third generation DM. When she completed her DM title, she also helped her own mother, GC Emau's Mausaic, DM earn her title at the tender age of 10! "Grand Illusion's" offspring are GP, RW Emau's DaVinci's Code, GC Emau's Make Believe, GP Emau's Maybe It's Magic, GP Emau's

Spot-Of-Americus and GC Emau's Trompe L'Oeil, all silver and all males! "Mausaic's" qualifying offspring are GC Emau's SamIam of Bacamamdit, GC Emau's Tukuyomi of Wisteria FL, GP Emau's Dead Man Walking, GP Emau's Rumble In The Jungle, and of course, her DM daughter Emau's Grand Illusion, DM. Congratulations to Melanie, Laurie and Susan for completing the DM title on these three Egyptian Mau girls, a breed that we don't see a lot of in the show ring.

Some DMs are special because they are in memory of, or dedicated to, fanciers that have left us. Bill and Sue Storten's Maine Coon female, GC Verismo Carmen of McKittycreek, DM, was bred by Tom and Janice Odom (Tom passed suddenly in March 2006, at a young age). "Carmen" is the grandmother of GC, NW Shubacoons Lincoln Park and GC, NW Shubacoons Desdemona of Highlander. Sue was present when Carmen's fifth offspring granded and said it was a very emotional moment for her, plus a tribute to Tom and his daughter Susan. Carmen's mother is also a DM, CH Angtini Floria Tosca of Verismo, DM. Carmen has a daughter who DM'd, CH McKittycreek Caliente, DM, which makes three generations of Maine Coon female DMs. Sue would like to thank those that helped her to grand Carmen's offspring - Teresa Signore, Judy Friedman, Sharon Stauch, Ramona and Paul Shuba and Valerie Boyle.

GC Tra-Mar Irish Dancer of Fuzzy-Foot, DM is an odd-eyed white Shorthair Manx male who DM'd in the 2007 show season. The Manx is one of the oldest natural breeds recognized by CFA, having been around since the 1930s, so it is somewhat amazing that "Danny," as he is known by his friends, is only the third Manx male DM. His grand sire, GC, NW Sinleo White Irish of Shelleo, DM, was the second Manx male DM. Danny was bred by Dayle and Marion Hall and R. Maring and is owned by Cathy and Jim Dinesen.


When Marion Hall passed away in 1997, Danny went to live with another noted Manx breeder – Becky Cotter of Cottori Cattery. About three years later Becky became ill and many of her cats went to be cared for by other people. Becky passed away in 2001 and Danny

came to live with the Dinesens. Cathy and Jim decided that they would finish Danny's DM title as a tribute to his breeders, the Halls, and to Becky Cotter, all of whom were considered dear friends and great contributors to the Manx breed. Three years later, the title was complete! Dayle and Marion had also produced five female DMs, but Danny is their first male. Cathy believes that the reason it is hard to produce a Manx male DM is that the kittens in Manx litters are not always tailless and their litters are small, usually ranging from one to three kittens. Of those kittens, only the rumpys and sometimes the rumpy risers can be shown; the stubbys

and tailed kittens are not show quality. Also to his credit, six of the grand offspring produced by Danny earned the RW title.

Sharon Lann of Forevermore Birmans also DM'd a cat that holds a special place in her heart, in part because of a friend that passed away. GC Forevermore's With Love of Celtic, DM, also known as "Sweetie," a seal point Birman female, was a gift from Sharon to her beloved mentor, J. Maureen Escalette of Celtic Birmans. Maureen suffered a stroke and was no longer able to care for Sweetie. so Sharon took Sweetie back. Sharon granded Sweetie before Maureen passed away and says that Sweetie's ribbons, rosettes and photos were proudly displayed in Maureen's hospital room before she died. Sweetie's offspring

included GC Forevermore's Andromeda of Dragonpaw, GP Forevermore Bling Bling, GC Forevermore You Won't Believe This (named that way because Sharon thought that he was a she, until her grandson pointed out what she had missed!), GC Forevermore Celtic Legacy, GP Forevermore Celtic Lore of Neostar and GP Forevermore Celtic Cross. Sharon included Celtic in the names of the last three cats in honor of Maureen's cattery name and in her honor. She says that she felt Maureen's hand more than once in Sweetie's show career and in her kittens – a lovely tribute to a mentor who has passed on.

On a lighter note, the second Sphynx DM is CH Majikmoon Dont B Jealous Qtee, DM, a red tabby and white female. "Jelly" was born while breeder/owner Rebekah Lewis was

out for some quick errands. Gone only 45 minutes, Rebekah came home to the kittens having been born, eyes wide open and mewing away. Apparently Sphynx kittens are often born with their eyes open, which surely frightens the breeders, who worry about damage to their tender eyes.

Jelly apparently relished being a mother and the act that causes motherhood, and as Rebecca reports, she would often mark the stove top to announce her amorous intentions. Rebecca says there is no odor like that of cooking urine. Rebecca got over the smell and the spraying, as Jelly's kittens grew into gorgeous adults. Jelly is the dam of the first

CFA Sphynx national winner, GC, PR, BW, NW Majikmoon Kugel Coruscate. "Kugel" carried on his mother's bad habit, and was well known for dressing the cages in the judges' rings with his scent. It is doubtful that many of the judges missed him when the season was over. Jelly also produced a regional winner, GP, RW Majikmoon Mibyg Johnson of Lincara, and three other grands - GP Majikmoon Sheik, GC Majikmoon Magnum of Enchantdlair and GC Majikmoon Serendipity of Kikapoo. The Sphynx breed has certainly enjoyed a meteoric rise since their reacceptance into CFA, and there are surely many more DMs to come.

Looking at the chart of distinguished merit cats by breed, the Persian continues to claim the top spot, both for the

previous year and historically. This is not surprising, since the Persian also has the most registrations. The Maine Coon has historically the fourth highest number of DMs, but in the 2006-2007 show season, they ranked second. Second highest historically is the Abyssinian, but they were in a tie for sixth in 2006-2007. One of our smaller breeds, the Japanese Bobtail, ranked third for the 2006-2007 show season, while they are ranked seventh historically.

Congratulations to the breeders and owners of the 123 cats that achieved their Distinguished Merit title in 2006-2007. While some may not have been great in the show ring, all of them gave something back to their breed – and that something is a bright future, with many more wonderful examples the pedigreed cats in our show rings. Best of luck to all! \blacksquare
