Owner's Responsibility: Please verify with the entry clerk that your entries were received.

Payment Information: Please make checks payable to Illini Cat Club. Full payment must accompany all mailed entries. Per Show Rules 6.21 and 6.20, all online entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first (cash, check or money orders accepted only), and the use of the online entry form is interpreted as an official entry in this CFA show and your email address on the form is considered to be your signature. No withdrawing entries once they're entered. There is a \$50 fee for any returned checks. Payment not received by 3/12/2022, will incur an additional \$50 late fee. All payments must be paid before the show. No payments will be accepted at the door. We will take PayPal and Square for payment.

Show Hours: Check in is from 7:30 - 8:30 AM on Saturday, with judging beginning at 9 AM both days. The advertised show hours are 9 AM to 5 PM on Saturday and 9 AM to 4 PM on Sunday.

Benching Requests: Every effort will be made to honor your benching requests to the best of our talents. A clerk near their rings is not counted as a request. Space provided, handicap requests will be benched at no charge to the exhibitor.

Hotel Information: Information will be sent with the entry confirmation.

Transportation: Exhibitors responsible for their own transportation. Midway Airport is closer to the show location than O'Hare.

Food: Food options will be sent with entry confirmation.

Miscellaneous: Show management will take reasonable care of cats and carriers but will not be responsible for damage or loss. **This is a NON-SMOKING facility and college campus.** If you must smoke, it needs to be in your car. Benching cage size is 22 x 22 x 22. Litter provided, bring your own pans.

Vetting: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL AND CFA MANDATORY COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS WILL BE OBSERVED. COVID BENCHING UPON REQUEST.
