Beaumont Municipal Airport – Approx 30 minute drive

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From I-10, take EXIT 877 toward TX-87/Orange/Newton.

Merge onto Lutcher Dr

Turn left onto N 16th St/TX-87

The showhall is on the left.

Show Hall: VFW Hall - Orange, is a handicapped-accessible facility that is air-conditioned and heated.

Show Rules:

All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. The Region reserves the right to add or substitute judges not named in the show flier should it become necessary.

Entry Information:

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Entry Clerk to confirm receipt of online entries. Neither the Entry Clerk nor Wildcatters Cat Club will be responsible for entries lost due to communication errors. Per show rule 6.21, all entries must be accompanied by proper entry fees. Entries sent online must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the show, whichever is first.

Entries must be received by 11:59pm February 22, 2022, or when limit of 225 cats is reached

No substitutions will be accepted after the closing date. No refunds made once your entry is received or for failure to bench.

Liability: Wildcatters Cat Club will take reasonable care to safeguard entries and the property of exhibitors. Neither the club nor The VFW Hall will be liable for any loss, damage or injury. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any damages they cause to the property.

Cages and Supplies:

Exhibitors must supply their own benching enclosures. Pop-up cages are available for purchase (\$20). Due to limited availability please advise the entry clerk if you need one.

Litter will be provided; bring your own litter pans, cat food and cat dishes.

NOTE: Per show rule 10.05, No more than two kittens or one cat may be benched in a single space whether entered for exhibition, competition, or benched for sale.

New Exhibitors:

Health Information:

This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, caliciviruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All entries must be free of fleas, ear mites, fungus, or any contagious or infectious illness. Claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not permitted in the show hall. No kittens under the age of 4 months will be permitted in the show hall.

TEXAS NO LONGER REQUIRES MANDATORY FACE MASKS, SOCIAL DISTANCING NOR RESTRICTED INDOOR CAPACITY LIMITS.

We do not expect spectators in the showhall.

CFA strongly recommends that anyone over the age of 2 wear a mask
