There will be two experimental rings at the Southern Region (CCPB) show. All opens, champions & premiers entered in the CCPB show will automatically be entered in the two experimental rings. There will be no extra charge for these rings, at the CCPB show. Top 10 Allbreed opens/champions will be in the championship final in this new ring and top 10 opens/premiers will be in the Premiership finals. These experimental rings are designed to award more grand points, so more cats will have the opportunity to "Grand". As the cost of everything is escalating, many people cannot afford to travel to as many shows; so Cat Club the Palm Beaches is pleased to bring this opportunity to our Regional Show. As listed on the flyer Russell Webb and Sharon Roy will be judging only the Experimental Rings. Judging for the Experimental Rings will start at 8:30 am on each day. By starting 30 minutes early we hope to have little or no impact on these cats getting to the regular rings.

Entry & Payment Info: Entries are accepted now. Fees include CFA surcharges. Please confirm online entries with the entry clerk; neither the club nor the entry clerk will be responsible for non-confirmed entries. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. Please pay in advance; you won't have to wait in line to get your catalog. Show Hall & Banquet Location: Sanford Civic Center, 401 E. Seminole Blvd. Sanford, FL 32771 Ph: 407-688-5000. The show hall is airconditioned and/or heated as needed and is handicapped accessible. Smoking is not permitted where cats are benched or judged. Lots of Free parking.

Show Hours: Check-in 7 – 8 am; judging both days will start at 8:30 for OPC rings; all other judging will start at 9 am both days.

Advertized Show Hours: 9 am – 4 pm (or end of finals) Saturday and Sunday.

Benching: Single cage size is approximate 22" x 22" x 22"; and is included with your entry. Exhibitors with a single entry using any size security cage are required to purchase an extra 1/2 cage. Clay litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter pans, cat food, and water/food dishes.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

Household Pets: All entries must be at least 4 months old; all entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Entries may not be declawed

Show Rules: CFA Show rules will be strictly enforced. Copy of rules may be obtained for \$7 from CFA, 260 E. Main St. Alliance, OH 44601. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. All cats/kittens for sale must have valid Florida Health Certificates as required by Florida Law. CCPB will not be responsible if this law is not followed.
