* **OCP Rings:** The Board approved 1 OCP ring each day ONLY if the following minimums are reached: 15 OPENS & PREMIERS for Premiership and 30 OPENS & CHAMPIONS for Championship. OCP rings will award top ten CH and top 10 PR from all the Opens, Champions and Premiers entered. These cats earn only Grand Points. If a judge does not have 3 LH and 3 SH CH in the top ten, they must name their 3 top LH and SH CH, in the case of PR their top 2 LH and SH.

Show Hall: Tall Cedars of Lebanon 2501 Putty Hill Ave. Parkville, MD 21234 PH: 410-668-4545. The show hall is a NON-SMOKING facility and is heated.

Entry & Payment Info: Entries are accepted now. Entry Fees include CFA & Regional surcharges. Please email entry clerk to confirm online entries. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. Make checks payable to Greater Baltimore Cat Club. PayPal is not available. Returned check fee is \$50 + all bank fees. **A Late fee of \$50 will be added to ANY fees not paid by 12/11/22.** No substitutions after the closing date. No refunds after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench.

Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections BEFORE CLOSING DATE.

Benching: ** Grooming space, sales cages & end of row space is extremely limited. Sales cages are only available WITH a paid entry. Single cage size is approximately 22" x 22" x 22" and is included with your entry. *EOR only available with even numbered entries or paid extra 1/2 cage.* **Exhibitors with an odd number of entries using any size security cage are required to purchase an extra 1/2 cage.** Litter is provided, bring litter boxes.

Check In & Show Hours: Check-in will begin at 7:30 am on Saturday; Cats not benched by 8:30 am will be marked absent and must checkin with the clerk in each ring. Report any transfers or absentees at check-in. The show will start at 9 am both Saturday and Sunday. The show hall will open at 8 am Sunday. **Show Hours:** 9 am-4 pm both days.

Hotel Info: There is no show hotel and the club has no recommendations.

Household Pet Entries: All entries must be at least 4 months old; all entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Entries may not be declawed.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. Under MD State law a rabies vaccine is required for all cats over the age of 4 months.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

This show is held under the auspices of the Cat Fanciers' Association. CFA show rules will be strictly enforced. Copies of the show rules are available for \$7 from CFA 260 East Main St. Alliance, OH 44601 or CFA: www.cfa.org
