Cats will need to be benched with their owners, and a space purchased for them through our entries, whether the cat is competing or not. (Example: Purchase the extra ½ cage @ \$20.)

Returned Check Fee is \$50 + ALL Bank fees **CASH ONLY** for entry fees paid at the door at check-in. PayPal is not available; no credit card payments. A Late Fee \$25 will be added to any fees paid after February 15, 2023.

Entry Info: Entries are accepted now. Entry Fees include CFA surcharges. Please email entry clerk to confirm online entries. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. No refunds after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench. No substitutions after the closing date. **Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE.** Club member fees are \$45 and is only for working members who actively work on show production tasks.

Show Hours: Check-in is 7:30-8:30 am on Saturday; the show will start at 9 am both days. **Advertised Show Hours:** 9 am - 4 pm both days.

Show Hotel Information will be sent with confirmation.

Local Airport: Detroit Metro Airport (DTW) is approximately 30 miles/40 minutes from the show hall.

Benching: Single cage size is approximately 22"x22"x22" and is included with your entry. Exhibitors with a single entry using any size security cage are required to purchase an extra 1/2 cage. * Sales cages are only available with a paid entry. Litter will be provided; please bring cat bowls and litter pans.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

Household Pets: All entries must be at least 4 months old; all entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Entries may not be declawed.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.
