**Miscellaneous:** Show management will take reasonable care of cats and carriers but will not be responsible for damage or loss. This is a NON-SMOKING facility and college campus. If you must smoke, it needs to be in your car. Benching cage size is 22 x 22 x 22. Litter provided, bring your own pans.

**Vetting:** It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry.

All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

**Scoring:** All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number (TRN).
