ENTRY INFO: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number. Fees must accompany entries and no fees will be refunded due to failure to bench. No postdated checks will be accepted. There will be a \$35.00 fee charged on all returned checks. Kittens must be four months of age or older on the opening day of the show. **In the event the show fills before closing, the club will accept entries for a waiting list as follows: Any entry received with payment in full will be given priority, followed by email entries with a time and date header. Show Rule 6.21 regarding payment for fax and email entries will be strictly enforced. Additional fees will be charged if fees are not received within 10 days of receipt of entry. No payment at check-in.**

ENTRY FEES: Make checks payable to: Los Colores Cat Club. or via PayPal to lccshow@gmail.com. **PayPal accepted via Friends/Family option only. The club is not responsible for fees if payment is submitted incorrectly.** First entry fee includes show catalog.

CLOSING DATE: Sunday, March 19, 2023, OR when 175 entry limit is reached.

HEALTH: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly recommended that all entries be tested for feline leukemia and inoculated for protection against feline enteritis, rhinotracheitis, calici virus, and chlamydia. All entries must be free of fungus and parasites. **EACH ENTRY MUST HAVE ALL CLAWS CLIPPED.** Declawed cats are not eligible for entry.

AMENITIES: Litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter trays, food, and dishes.

CAGES: NO CAGES ARE PROVIDED. SPACE PROVIDED IS 22" x 21". Double cage space is an additional 22". If your cage is larger than 44" you must purchase a groom space. No more than one cat or two kittens may be benched in the same cage.

AWARDS: Ribbons and rosettes will be awarded in accordance with CFA show rules. Permanent flats will be used with satin flats available upon request. For a copy of the current CFA show rules, send \$7.00 to the Cat Fancier's Association, 260 E Main St., Alliance, OH 44601, or <https://cfa.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/03/22-23show-rules.pdf>. The club reserves the right to add judges not named to judge non-championship, Household Pet and veteran classes.

SHOW INFORMATION AND HOURS: Check in is from 7:30 – 8:30 a.m. The show will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and is scheduled to end at 4:30 p.m.

HOUSEHOLD PET INFO: Household pets 8 months of age or older must be spayed or neutered. ALL nails must be clipped and cats should be bathed. Contact the show manager if this is your first show and you have questions.

VETERANS: Must be registered and at least 7 years old to be entered in this class.

SHOW HALL INFO: Palm Springs Leisure Center, 401 S. Pavilion Way, Palm Springs. Show hall is air conditioned or heated, depending upon the weather, and has ample parking. Smoking is not permitted in the show hall. From the west, take I-10 and exit Hwy. 111 into the city, turning left on Vista Chino, right on Sunrise, left on Baristo and right at the first stop sign. From the east, take I-10 to the Date Palm exit. Follow signs to Date Palm Dr., turn left. Go to Vista Chino and turn right, then left on Sunrise, left on Baristo and right at the stop sign.

At this time we do plan on using the kitchen to sell food, but limited items, i.e. plain waffles only, tri-tip sandwiches and salads. COVID procedures for food service will be followed. Updates will be posted to the Southwest Region groups.io list and the regional website as needed.
