NOTE: You must stay at hall till end of advertised judging hours.

ENTRY

Entry closing date is Sunday 9.4.2023 kello 18.00 at Finnish time or as soon as 150 cats are entered, whichever is sooner. According the CFA Show Rules every entered cat must be paid within 10 days of receipt or before the show, whichever is sooner. No cancellations allowed but it is possible to change or update cats information till entry closing date. Not entries by mail.

Cat Fanciers Finland is not responsible for misdirected or lost entries. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure receipt of entry by the Entry Clerk prior to the closing of the show. Please, enter your cat in time to avoid any problem

SANITARY REQUIREMENTS

This is a non-vetted show, but vaccinations will be checked at check in, so bring your vaccination records with you. No kittens under 4 months of age will be allowed in the show hall. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall are inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia, feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching.

Under current CFA show rules, show management reserves the right to have any cat showing signs of illness, disease or parasites removed from the show hall, in order to protect other cats in the show. De-clawed cats are not eligible for entry. All household pet entries over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered. Finnish animal protection law requires cat must have litter box and water bowl all the time in cage.

Finland is having the same importing regulations as rest of the Europe. Check current importing regulations from Finnish Food Authority Ruokavirasto. It is owners responsibility to check all importing regulations and keep cats records updated.

HOTELS AND TRANSPORTATION

There are no specific show hotel. Lots of pet friendly hotels in close by area. Pasila train station (community trains!) other side of the show hall. We have listed alternative hotels and transportation companies with our online show flyer at www.cfasuomi.org.

BENCHING REQUEST

Benching requests will be limited to one per exhibitor and will be honored when possible. Please, no negative benching requests.

CAGES

Club is only offering a table space and you bring your own cage. Your cage must fit 65cm x 65cm space, otherwise you need to book double cage space. No more than one cat or two kittens may be benched in a single cage. Benching will be in rows.

CAT LITTER

There is litter available at the show hall but if you take the litter at show hall, you need to take it with you to home. It is not allowed to put cat litter in trash bins. We would recommend that you bring your own litter and take the litter back home and reuse it. This way we all support environment.

CHAIRS

Limited number of chairs available. Ask from club officers at show hall.

PARKING

There is a parking fee at the parking house, but special parking fee for exhibitors still under negotiation. We will inform about prices in our extra info-letter couple days before the show.

FOOD

There are many different fast food restaurants at Messukeskus. You are also allowed to use special exhibitor canteen at second floor close to main entrance door at Messukeskus.

All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.
