- Dallas - 2 hr. drive south on I-35E to I-35. Belton is south of Temple on I-35
- Austin - 1 hr. drive north on I-35. Belton is north of Georgetown
- Killeen - 30 min. drive east on 121 loop towards Belton.

**Lunch:** The facility has food available for purchase.

**Show Rules:**

All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. The Region reserves the right to add or substitute judges not named in the show flier should it become necessary.

**Entry Information:**

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to contact the Entry Clerk to confirm receipt of online entries. Neither the Entry Clerk, North Texas nor Show & Tell Clubs will be responsible for entries lost due to communication errors. Per show rule 6.21, all entries must be accompanied by proper entry fees. Entries sent online must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the show, whichever is first.

No substitutions will be accepted after the closing date. No refunds made once your entry is submitted or for failure to bench.

**Exhibitors must supply their own benching enclosures.** Pop-up cages are available for purchase (\$20). Due to limited availability please advise the entry clerk if you need one.

Litter will be provided; bring your own litter pans, cat food and cat dishes.

NOE: Per show rule 10.05, No more than two kittens or one cat may be benched in a single space whether entered for exhibition, competition, or benched for sale.

**Health Information:**

This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, caliciviruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All entries must be free of fleas, ear mites, fungus, or any contagious or infectious illness. Claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not permitted in the show hall. No kittens under the age of 4 months will be permitted in the show hall.
