Entry & Payment Info: Entries accepted now. Entry fees include CFA & Regional surcharges. Per show rule 5.01, all entries may only be received through the CFA online entry form on the CFA website. Per show rule 6.21, each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online/fax entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. PayPal is accepted, must use "Friend & Family" please. PayPal email is catsincredible2@gmail.com. **CASH ONLY WILL BE ACCEPTED AT CHECK-IN.** No substitutions after the closing date. No refunds after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench. **CHECK your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections BEFORE CLOSING DATE.**

Show Hall: LuLu Shriners Hall, 5140 Butler Pike, Plymouth Meeting, PA (610 828-9050). The show hall is heated or air conditioned as needed and handicap accessible. Lots of free parking. No alcoholic beverages or smoking permitted in show hall.

Check-in: Sat. 7:30-8:30 am. Any cat not benched by 8:30 am will be marked absent. Please report any transfers or absentees at check-in.

Judging Hours: Saturday: 9 am – 5 pm (or until completion of finals)/ Sunday 8:30 am – 4 pm (or until completion of finals).

Local Airport Info: Philadelphia International Airport – 35 minutes (Approximately 28 miles)

Household Pets: All Household Pets over the age of 8 (eight) months must be neutered or spayed. HHPs may not be declawed.

Benching: Single cage is approximately 22"x22"x22" and is included with your entry. Exhibitors with a single entry using any size security cage are required to purchase an extra ½ cage. ***Sales cages are only available with a paid entry.** Cat litter will be provided; please bring a litter box.

Health: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Claws of all cats entered in competition must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number. By entering, exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and the show committee and to adhere to CFA show rules. CFA show rules may be obtained for \$7 each from CFA plus \$2 shipping, 260 E. Main Street, Alliance, OH 44601.
