Show Hall: Jacob Building, Chilhowee Park, 339 Lakeside Street, Knoxville, TN. Show Hall is handicap accessible, has heat and air conditioning. People food, drinks (including beer & wine) will be available to purchase on-site. Parking is free. **NO outside alcohol will be allowed in the showhall!!!**

Catalog Info: Entry fees no longer include a paper catalog. After the show closes, each exhibitor will receive a link to the show catalog from the Entry Clerk. It is suggested you print the pages you will need (e.g. the pages that include your entries, the Unofficial Count page, and the pages for the finals). If you prefer to pay for a paper catalog, you must request it and pay the paper catalog fee of \$10.

Entry & Payment Info: Entry Fees include CFA & Regional surcharges. Per show rule 5.01, all entries may only be received through the CFA online entry form on the CFA website. Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All online entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. Make checks payable to Tennessee Valley Cat Fanciers, Inc. (TVCF, Inc) Returned check fee is \$50 + ALL bank fees. **Zelle & paypal** accepted, if you have both, please use Zelle (paypal use Friends & Family please), email for both is shagcat@stelznan.net, CASH ONLY at the door. Please confirm online entries by email with the entry clerk. No substitutions after the closing date. No refund after the entry clerk has confirmed your entry or for failure to bench.

Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with any corrections BEFORE CLOSING DATE.

Scoring: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

Supplies and Miscellaneous: Cage is approximately 22" x 22" x 22" and is included with your entry. Litter will be provided, but bring your own litter pans, food dishes, and cat food. Novice exhibitors, bring cage curtains and grooming aids. Please bring cats in suitable carriers.

Show Hours: Check-in: Saturday 7:30 am-8:30 am. Judging will begin at 9 am Saturday & Sunday, show hours 9a-4p both days or until the completion of judging.

Household Pets: All entries must be at least 4 months old; all entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed, cannot be declawed.

Non-vetted Show: All cats should be free of fleas, fungus, mites, and contagious diseases. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici virus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. No kittens below 4 months of age allowed in showhall.

Fly Ins: Knoxville's McGhee Tyson Airport is about 25 minutes from the show hall. We are not able to offer transportation for exhibitors.

Show Hotel: None specified; there are several pet friendly hotels nearby (Red Roof & La Quinta to North, East & West, and more).
