THE SHOW HALL: Hamilton County Fairgrounds, 2003 Pleasant Street, Noblesville, IN
The Cat club nor the show hall will not be responsible for any personal injury, loss or damage to personal property. The facility is heated and air conditioned.

PEOPLE FOOD WILL BE AVAILABLE :

Food and drinks will be available for purchase. There are also several fast food outlets, delis and casual eateries within a mile of the show hall. Outside food and grand parties are allowed.

CHECK-IN: Check-in is from 7:30 am – 8:30 am est. NO EARLY SETUP ON FRIDAY.

Judging will start at 9 am and go until all finals are completed.

Advertised gate hours are 9 am-5:00 pm.

HEALTH: This is a non-vetted show. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia, feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching.

CFA SHOW RULES: CFA Show Rules will govern this show. A copy of the show rules can be downloaded from the CFA website at <https://cfa.org/wp-content/uploads/2025/04/25-26show-rules.pdf>.

BENCHING REQUEST: Benching requests will be limited to one per exhibitor and will be honored if possible.

SPACE: EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN BENCHING ENCLOSURES One cat or two kittens may be benched per cage. Exhibitors with their own cages will need to purchase the extra ½ cage.

Litter will be provided. Bring your own litter pans.

ENTRIES AND FEES: Make check payable to No Drama Llama Cat Society or pay electronically upon receipt of Square invoice. Entries may only be received through the CFA online entry form on the CFA website. There will be a \$75.00 service charge for returned checks along with any incurred bank fees.

Per CFA show rule, entries must be paid in full within ten (10) days of receipt of confirmation or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. No payment at the door.

Entry fees will not be refunded for failure to bench.

Any entry in Championship, Premiership, Provisional or AOV classes must be submitted with a CFA registration number.

AIRPORT: IND - Indianapolis International is the closet airport to the show hall.
